EMDR Uniting Nations: Promoting peace within and between people

Having experienced armed conflict, war, disaster or persecution as well as forced migration, both children and adults run a substantial risk of developing posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and other psychological scars. Therefore, one of the central themes of this years' conference speaks to EMDR's role in humanitarian projects as well as to its ability to have a positive impact on communities who went through traumatic experiences.

The European EMDR Conference, that will take place in Geneva on June 6-8 2013, is organized in co-operation with UNITAR, the United Nations Institute for Training and Research. UNITAR has the important role of conducting research and training for UN agencies in the fields of environment, peace, security, diplomacy and governance. The keynote speakers will come from different parts of the world and from different organizations, and will tell us about their diverse work. Some will address specific EMDR projects, while others will speak to the spirit of EMDR: Healing, Service to people and communities, Innovation and deeper understanding of humanity.

The workshops will provide the participants with the state of the art of EMDR practice, given by some of the best teachers in the EMDR field. They will be a show case of "the best EMDR can offer – 2013".

For the first time, this EMDR Europe conference will have a special track for UN and humanitarian agencies personal. This track will provide its participants with an overview of EMDR, what EMDR is capable of, as well as a deeper look at current research about EMDR. The topics will include work with refugees, with abused children, after natural disasters and in acute trauma, with people who were kidnapped, and with relief workers. All these presentations will converge to one common message: the healing of trauma can promote peace within and between people.




